

Ary Crafts, the owner of Culinary Crafts Catering in Salt Lake City, Utah, has created a leadership scholarship for those professionals who want to take their business to the next level as well as become a future leader in the ICA and catering industry. An 11-time winner of *Utah's Best of State in Catering*, Crafts knows a few things about getting to, and staying at, the top. She was also awarded the ICA 2013 Caterer of the Year and The Catersource "ACE" Award — 2013.

This scholarship includes tuition to both *The Art of Catering Food* and the *Catersource* conference in Las Vegas. It also offers one-on-one mentoring for four days at *Culinary Crafts*, including airfare and accommodations.

Requirements include:

- 1) Five years of experience in the catering industry as owner, officer or manager of a company;
- 2 Documentation of business license, forms, menus with price points and photos. All held in strictest confidence;
- 3 A written reference from an ICA/ICAEF current or past board member;
- 4 A personal and in-depth phone interview;
- 5 A sentence stating the applicant's willingness to serve on an ICA committee before or during the scholarship process.
- 6 Applicant must be employed by catering company that is an ICA Member in good standing for a minimum of one full year.
